Event Information

Congress:

Friday 2nd Nov: 1800hrs the World Congress will take place, all are welcome to attend. Any questions for consideration are to be staffed through your National Representative or President to the WDFPF Secretary.

World Powerlifting Championships Weigh-In:

Sat 3rd Nov: 0730 weigh in for all Women and Male up to 75kg lifters, this includes all equipped lifters in these classes.

Sun 4th Nov: 0730 weigh in for Male 82.5kg lifters and above, this includes all equipped lifters in these weigh classes.

NOTE: All lifters must be present at the scheduled weigh in time. **Weigh in closes at 0830.** Any lifter arriving after this time will NOT be allowed to lift having missed the scheduled weigh in time. It is the lifters responsibility to make all reasonable travel arrangements to meet the weigh in time.

Entry:

The event fees are:

1st entry £65.00
2nd entry £15.00

Note- If you are entering the equipped and unequipped you will pay £80.00 total, if you are only entering one of the events you will pay £65.00.

Closing dates for entries to your National Representative is
1st October 2018.

Registration:

All payment from International lifters are to be made in **Great British Pounds** on the day lifting at registration. All those not in attendance

but entered on the team list will be liable to 50% of the entry cost.

At registration all lifters on collection of their weigh-in cards will be required to sign a declaration indicating that they participate at their own risk, that they have appropriate cover, that they are free from any medical conditions that may prevent participation, that they expect their name to appear on published results and all aspects of drugs testing procedures including result promulgation.

Drugs testing:

This will be conducted in line with WDFPF minimum requirements of 10% of athletes participating. No lifter can leave the venue on the day they are lifting without express permission of the WDFPF Drugs Control Officers. Even though the event is required to have 10% testing the WDFPF and any member affiliate may choose to test further individuals as it sees fit to meet its testing requirements. Any lifter or individual nominated for testing must produce a sample and any failure to do so will result in an immediate life ban for refusal of testing.

Trophy Presentation:

The trophies will be presented to the top 3 lifters with best lifter male and female trophies.

NO presentations will be made outside of the main timings, lifters are to be aware that any request to obtain trophies outside of the announced timings will not be able to collect awards.

UK flights will be to Glasgow International airport. It is 8 miles outside of
the city. You can get a bus for £9 from the airport to the city Centre
(Buchanan Bus Station) or a taxi to the City Centre is roughly
£20. Glasgow Prestwick international 34 miles from city, but only
